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The general arrangement of the manuscripts should be the following: title: Short, attractive, accurate, honest, and consistent with the international nomenclature of diseases (who), with a maximum of 12-15 words. **AUTHORS:** First and last names; the first place will belong to the editor of the work; the order of the other authors will correspond to their contribution. It shall include the full address of the principal author and his/her e-mail address, specialty and the name of the institution where the work was carried out, and the complete data of the co-authors. You must also have among the authors a specialist in the oncology branch to which the manuscript refers.
